

HOW TO USE

Printing Foam

Draw on to the foam with a semi blunt instrument (pencil, popstick). Face upwards and roll on water-based paint or ink. Apply a sheet of paper over the foam, smooth out gently with the hand. Peel off paper immediately for a print. May repeat many times with re-inking.



PROCESS

Step 1: Produce the 'block' by simply pressing lines and areas into the special soft foam surface. Use a 4B pencil or ballpoint pen.

Step 2: Ink the surface with any kind of waterbased printing ink or paint with a foam roller. Carefully lay a sheet of paper over the inked surface and rub all over with a hard roller, or with the back of a spoon, or palm of the hand.

Step 3: Peel off the print, slowly. Repeat the inking and rubbing for as many prints as desired. Experiment with different coloured inks and different coloured papers.

Step 4: To wash the block, simply hold under the tap or soak in a dish of water. The surface and lines may be carefully cleaned with a soft brush. The block will store easily for future use, when completely dry.
